Admission of Graduate Students "MSc in Logistics& Supply Chain Management"

The English-taught MSc in Logistics & Supply Chain Management has been developed over the years to take into account advances in the field of logistics and supply chain management as well as improvements and innovations in the associated computer-based technologies available to practitioners and researchers in logistics. The programme has been designed to develop the required skills and build students' confidence to become the future leaders in logistics.

The AUTh MSc in Logistics and Supply Chain Management is a very rigorous academic programme, that develops in students not only the special knowledge required for performance at the highest professional levels in these areas but in addition provides them with an opportunity to acquire the essential skills for top management positions. Students attending this programme will be exposed to a multifaceted perspective of marketing and will acquire analytical and critical skills to help organisations solve problems, identify market opportunities, and achieve their full potential. All modules will be taught by academic staff, who have expertise in the areas they teach, while logistics executives will provide the opportunity to gain real life industry perspectives.

The programme extends over 18 months, consisting of a one-year full-time period during which ten core modules are taken, followed by a research /consultancy project as part of the MSc dissertation requirement.
